The community gives about 16,400 hours of volunteer time at the Mission every year.



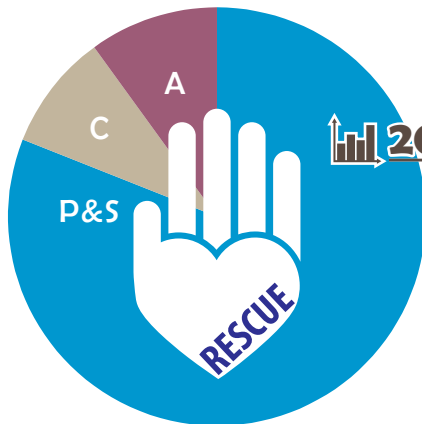
DID YOU KNOW?
